


Secret Bible Translation

Note: Wycliffe Associates' volunteers provide labor and other services for various ministry activities. Contributed services (GAAP) meeting the criteria for revenue recognition in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States amounted to approximately \$11,774,000 and are included in the Statement of Activities as "contributed services and facilities usage" revenue. Volunteer services (non-GAAP) during the year ending September 30, 2025 not meeting the criteria for recognition in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States, have been estimated by management to be approximately \$1,085,000 (unaudited). Although these services have a significant impact on making the ministry effective, the estimated value of such services is not reflected in the financial statements.
